Being surrounded by music and creative people is a great way to spend your day. We specialize in voice training and vocal coaching and love teaching how to play an instrument.

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") describes the "personal information" we collect about you, how we use it, how we share it, your rights and choices, and how you can contact us regarding our privacy practices. 1. An overview of data protection

General
